She enjoyed shopping and spending time with her beloved family.

Claudia is survived by her husband of 51 years, Willie J. "Will" Crain. Together, they had a son and daughter in law Troy and Candy Crain and a granddaughter Presley Crain, all of Bogalusa. She leaves behind a sister and brother in law Debbie Adams Peterson and Darryl Peterson of Bogalusa and a brother and sister in law Greg and Bridget Miley of McComb, MS. She will also be missed by her niece Elizabeth Miley Norman of McComb, and nephews J.R.
