Adam had a special place in his heart for his "fur babies", his pet dogs. However, his favorite pastime was spending time with his beloved wife, children and grandchildren.

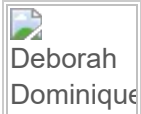
He was preceded in death by his parents Adam Francis Galley, Sr. and
