BENJAMIN GEORGE NORTHCUTT, AGE 44

Was born in Nashville, TN and was a resident of Enon, LA. He died Sunday night November 2, 2008, as a result of an accident in Livingston, LA. Ben was the beloved husband of Laurel Kirby Green Northcutt and the adored father of sons William Green Northcutt and Bankston Lyle Northcutt.
