And a resident of Mt. Hermon died late Tuesday night August 23, 2016 at the Heritage Manor Nursing Home. Bill was a mechanic of the Washington Parish Court House for 32 years after receiving his degree from Sullivan Vocational School. He was a past president of the Washington Parish Federation of the Blind and represented his group at the state level in Baton Rouge. Despite that disability, Bill achieved many more things not considered possible. He was a longtime piano tuner and re-builder and was an honorary deputy of the Washington Parish Sheriff's Office. Bill was a professional musician that traveled throughout the area playing in church revival services as well as the services of his church, Mt. Hermon Pentecostal. Bill had the opportunity to travel and play music in Nashville, TN several times but passed to continue his Lord's work by helping to plant numerous churches and Christian schools. He believed in second chances for all people and he had a favorite saying “If there is a Will, there is a Way”, as his life has proven.
