Brad was born in Pueblo, Colorado on February 24, 1947 and graduated from Central High School in 1965 then later earned a psychology degree from Southern Colorado State College in 1969 before moving to Franklinton. He was the co-founder and owner/operator of Orman & Bickham Real Estate in Franklinton for over 40 years. Brad was a licensed real estate broker and appraiser and also a longtime member of the Northshore Area Board of Realtors. Through his business, Brad was a member of the Franklinton Chamber of Commerce, serving as President for a time and a longtime team sponsor with Dixie Youth Baseball. He was also a member and past President of the Franklinton Lion's Club and the Mile Branch Settlement Committee.
