He was a resident of Trenton, Georgia and was born to Herbert and Marjorie Sisson in Bastrop, Louisiana on November 20, 1956. Bruce graduated from Franklinton High School (1974), and attended Southeastern Louisiana University (1975-76), and Tennessee Temple (1991-1993). He also served in the United States Army at White Sands in Texas. Following his honorable discharge, Mr. Sisson remained in the inactive Army Reserve. Bruce had a lengthy career in floor covering sales, installation, and service. Mr. Sisson was a member of First Centenary United Methodist Church in Chattanooga, Tennessee. He will be sadly missed by his family.
