Robert Carey Bateman, age 89, passed away on Friday, November 19, 2021. A Washington Parish native, Carey was born to the late Robert H. Bateman and Sadie Sylvest Bateman. He is survived by his wife of 66 years Marie Gennaro Bateman, sons and daughters in law Dr. Robert Carey Bateman Jr and Maureen Bateman, Rodney Michael Bateman and Cecily Bateman, daughter and son in law Juhn Marie Bateman Green and Dick Green, grandchildren and spouses Richard Carey Green (Valerie), Anne Marie Bettencourt (Jerry), Robert Michael Bateman, Samuel Paul Bateman, Drs. Carey graduated from Franklinton High School, Pearl River Junior College, and Southeastern Louisiana University. He served two years in the US Army with 16 months spent in Korea. Carey retired after 40 years as a successful Allstate Insurance salesman. He was also a licensed real estate agent and Notary Public. Carey served on the Washington-St Tammany Electric Coop Board of Directors since May 2003.

He was an active member of First Baptist Church of Franklinton and the Fellowship Sunday School class. He is a past member of the Franklinton Jaycees, Rotary Club, and Chamber of Commerce as well as the National Wild Turkey Federation, the NRA, Washington Parish Farm Bureau, and the
