On Monday, August 01, 2011 at 4:23 AM Charlie Bounds, age 86 died peacefully at his home in Thomas.

He was a retired employee of Louisiana Department of Highway, a lifetime member of Stateline United Pentecostal Church, and a member of the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Mr. Bounds was a Private First Class World War II Veteran. He served in combat from June 29, 1943 with the 45th Infantry Division and on December 9, 1945, he received an Honorable Discharge while with the Company A, 179th Infantry. For his exemplary service, Mr. Bounds was awarded 3 Purple Hearts, 3 Bronze Stars, American Theater Campaign Medal, 2 Good Conduct Medals, Victory Ribbon, 1 Overseas Bar, Combat Infantryman Badge, American Campaign Medal, European African Middle Eastern Campaign Medal and World War II Victory Medal.
