



## Clint Dillon

March 29, 1974 - July 11, 2007

Bryan Clint Dillon, 33, a native of Franklinton, Louisiana and a resident of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, passed away on July 11, 2007. He was a graduate of Bowling Green School in Franklinton and Louisiana State University, with degrees in Economics and Political Science.

His career included a tenure as an economic development advisor with the Peace Corp in Honduras. He also worked as a legislative aide in Washington, D.C.. At the time of his death, he was employed as a foreign language instructor with the George County School System. He served as a medical specialist with the Army National Guard. An avid LSU fan, he supported his Tigers from near and far, and maintained close relationships with high school and college friends.

Clint is survived by his parents, Richard and Dianne Dillon of Franklinton; two brothers and their wives, Grant and Pam Dillon of Austin, Texas and Dr. Darren and Marnie Dillon of Montgomery, Alabama; his grandmother, Althea Magee of Franklinton; three nephews and two nieces, Steve and Dustin Short of Austin, TX and Maclou, William, and Marguerite Dillon of Montgomery, Alabama; and a special friend, Belen Wagner of Mobile, AL.
