After graduating, he proudly served in the United States Air Force, stationed in California until completing his 4 year duty. He held numerous positions with the club, such as Area Governor, Vice President, and President. In most recent years, you could always visit with him at Brooks General Store having coffee and great food at least three times a day, where you could get his opinion on any subject matter.
