Houston Hulon "Sam" Sheridan born October 16th 1940 died Monday July 13th 2015 after a brief illness. Mr. Sheridan was the son of Houston and Jessie Duncan Sheridan. He attended Pine school. Mr. Sheridan served in the US Army and later married Sandra Kay Gates in 1961 they divorced in 1996. Mr. Sheridan joined the Pipefitters/Steamfitters Union and later became an accomplished pipe welder.
