Mrs. Ivy came to the United States in 1947 and married Cary Spencer on September 2nd, 1948. She became a naturalized citizen on June 11th, 1951. Prior to entering the United States, as a young girl, she was part of an operation "Pied Piper". Operation Pied Piper evacuated close to a million children out of London in 1940 due to the constant bombing of London by Germany. She and her brother were evacuated to Penmamaw, Wales. In her earlier years, she enjoyed gardening and reading. She read most of the books in the Franklinton Library. Ivy and Cary enjoyed traveling the country and overseas. After Mrs. Ivy lost her beloved husband, she enjoyed watching TV shows like Star Trek, Harry Potter, and her favorite Perry Mason, and spending her days with her children.
