He was preceded in death by his parents Edward Burns and Ethel Sanders Burns and brothers Jim Burns and Bob Burns.

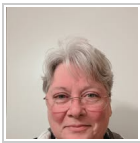

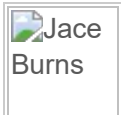
