JAMES BENNIE “Pa Pa” JONES, JR., AGE 69

And a resident of the Zona community near Enon passed away Saturday April 30, 2022 at Lakeview Regional Medical Center. He was a graduate of Bogalusa High School before joining the United States Army. James served his country as a helicopter crewman and mechanic during the Vietnam War era stationed in Germany. Upon his return to Louisiana, James drove trucks for many different companies over the years, including both local and cross-country trips. His CB handle was always “Weed Hopper” and he also drove commercial and church busses for different groups. Most recently, he drove delivery trucks for Smith & Smith, Inc. James was Chief #801 of the District 8 Volunteer Fire Department, having proudly served in that leadership role since the district’s formation in 1994. He was also a member of the Sons of Confederate Veterans Washington Rifles Camp 2211 and also the Mechanized Cavalry (1st Battalion, Company B, 4th Platoon) since 2016 and often helped in the cleanup of cemeteries as well as reenactments and other events at Camp Moore. James enjoyed riding his Harley Davidson motorcycle and watching deer and other wildlife feed on his property. He had a pond built near his home so he could feed the fish and then catch them with his beloved grandchildren. James also enjoyed going to all their sports games, dance recitals and events every chance that he could.
