and a resident of the Stony Point Community passed away Tuesday morning June 4, 2024 at his home surrounded by his family. He was born April 24, 1941 and was the Co-Valedictorian of Mount Hermon High School Class of 1959. James then attended Louisiana College before graduating with a Bachelor's Degree in mathematics from Southeastern Louisiana University in 1963. He would later receive his Master's Degree from Auburn University in 1965. He married Mary Michalos on September 19, 1964. Together they lived in Huntsville, Alabama and Houston, Texas while he was employed with IBM from 1965 until retiring in 1996 when he then served with the United Space Alliance for 10 years before retiring for good in 2006. James worked on the Sky Lab reentry program, the Space Shuttle and Saturn Rocket launches during his career and he was always very proud of the fact that he helped "put a man on the moon" during his service to the U.S. Space Program. He also lived in Baton Rouge for several years, before they moved back to Washington Parish in 2015. James was always a devoted husband, father and brother that enjoyed spending time with his family and friends.
