JENNIFER LEE FLEMING, AGE 73

and a lifelong resident of Franklinton passed away Friday evening June 30, 2023 at University Hospital in New Orleans. She was a Class of 1967 graduate of Franklinton High School, where she was a member of the cheerleading squad. Jenny then obtained a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) from Southeastern Louisiana University and worked in nursing home care, home health and was the nurse for the Washington Parish School System throughout the parish. She taught an adult LPN class for a time and later retired as a nurse for the State of Louisiana, one of her duties was working alongside the Office of Emergency Preparedness following the destruction of Hurricane Katrina. During her children's early years, Jenny took a break from nursing and operated the Gingerbread House day-care for nearly 10 years. She was a "mother" to a huge number of children that have fond memories of Mrs. Jenny still to this day.

Jenny was a talented craft-maker and artist. Her design was chosen as the Washington Parish Fair Doubloon in 1988 and recently her painting was the 2022 Washington Parish Fair Poster. Jenny volunteered at Mile Branch Settlement, where she often sold her crafts, and worked with other areas the Fair. She enjoyed reading, traveling to the Gulf Coast and spending time with her friends and their families on camp outs, LSU games, Mardi Gras parades,

float trips on the Bogue Chitto and other family parties. Recently she really liked to get together with her classmates over dinner to share stories of “the good old days”. She also enjoyed working in her flower gardens and going out to eat with her daughter, as the two of them seemed to be inseparable. Jenny loved spending time with her children and grandchildren, following and supporting them in all their activities.

During that time, I knew Ms. Jenny mostly through telephone calls. I would complain to Ms. Jenny that Mechelle had a habit of waking me up past midnight, craving a chocolate shake from Hardee's (among other things! lol). We finally met at Fort Meade, Maryland when Mr. Wayne and Ms. Jenny came to help Mechelle set-up her home. I immediately felt the tight bond they had as a family. It was a bond I had not experienced in my lifetime. I also learned Ms. Jenny's role in the family...keeping tabs on Mr. Wayne and calming down Mechelle! What I did not expect was Ms. Jenny being my second mother. From that day, I would visit Franklinton, LA to experience the Washington Parish Free Fair and Mardi Gras celebrations. While my Air Force career kept me from being physically present, whenever we talked it was if we had never been apart. I was her "Mitch #2."

The last time we saw each other was in Arizona, as both Mr. Wayne and my mother were battling cancer. Despite Mr. Wayne's fragile condition, Ms. Jenny took the time to make the trip to visit my mom at the hospital. That's just one example of how caring and selfless Ms. Jenny was. The exhaustion and pain of Mr. Wayne's battle took a toll, but she still made time for me and my mother. Little did I know she would soon be faced with her own battle - one she fought with courage and strength.

Ms. Jenny...I miss you so much it hurts. While your earthly body is no longer with us, your soul is very much alive and present as we grieve your loss. I know for certain you are with Mr. Wayne, looking down on us and holding Mechelle, Matt, Mitch and grandkids in your arms.
