



Jerry Malcolm Wascom

July 2, 1945 - October 20, 2016

JERRY MALCOLM WASCOM, AGE 71, a resident of Franklinton, LA, died on Thursday, October 20, 2016, at Ochsner's Medical Center, in New Orleans, LA, after a short illness. Mr. Wascom was a long-time business education teacher and sponsor of the Future Business Leaders of America Program at Mt. Hermon School, retiring after 30 years in the classroom. After leaving the classroom, he served as church administrator at First Baptist Church, Franklinton, LA. As an active member of FBC, Franklinton, he served as deacon, choir member, and ringer in the handbell choir. Jerry served his country during the Vietnam era as a member of the United States Air Force.

He is survived by his wife of almost 36 years, Marie Cothorn Wascom, of Franklinton; one daughter and son-in-law, Kristen Wascom Stocks and Bo Jason Stocks, of Dixon, Wyoming; two grandchildren, Katelyn Nicole and Colt Jason Stocks.

He is also survived by one sister, Margaret Wascom Williamson, of Mt. Hermon, LA; one brother-in-law, Richard Cothorn of Bogalusa, LA; four nephews and their spouses, Brad Williamson and Pamela Fontenot Williamson; Patrick Williamson; Bart Pierce; Darin Cothorn and Lorrie Wells Cothorn; one niece and spouse, Keri Cothorn King and Brian King; as well as numerous great nieces.

Mr. Wascom was preceded in death by his parents, Doyle D. and Ozzie Ott Wascom; a brother-in-law, Charles T. Williamson; a sister-in-law, Sylvia Martin Cothorn; and a great niece, Sarah Elizabeth Williamson.
