He worked as a pipe-welder for Avondale Shipyards for 25 years with the latter years as a foreman and superintendent. Joe was a talented welder that created many special techniques and procedures, which he was recognized for and the company still uses to this day, including the first welding applications for Titanium. He served his country and community in the Louisiana Army-National Guard for six years. Joe loved God first and foremost in his life and read his Bible every day, even acting as a Bible scholar to family and fellow church members. He attended United Faith UPC in Bogalusa for several years and was a member of Stateline United Pentecostal Church for the last 20 years. Joe had obtained a theological degree and often served his churches as an associate pastor, Sunday School teacher and Superintendent and many other duties, anything needed to help his church family. He enjoyed woodworking and later in life began drawing in his spare time. Joe had a fun-loving personality and could do spot-on imitations of people and characters including the perfect accents. He was a very genuine and humble person and always had an uplifting spirit that he shared while visiting with the people he met.
