And a longtime resident of Franklinton, Louisiana died Thursday June 3, 2021 at the Lawrence County Nursing Center in Monticello, Mississippi after a lengthy illness. He was born in Crowville, Louisiana on November 15, 1932 to the late Herman L. Daughdrill and Mattie Thorne Daughdrill. Ken was a United States Marine Corps veteran of the Korean War.
