JAMES LARRY MILLER, AGE 78

And a resident of Mt. Hermon died Friday evening June 16, 2017 at St. Tammany Parish Hospital. He was a Vietnam War era veteran of the United States Air Force which began a career of 21 years. Larry worked at the former Washington Bank for 14 before a career as a Washington Parish Sheriff's Deputy for 17 years. During this time, he also served as a Justice of the Peace in Mt. Hermon for 32 years. Larry enjoyed playing softball in his younger days and also liked working on his computer, but his main hobby was work and the service he provided to his community. He was longtime active member of Mt. Hermon Baptist Church, where he was a deacon for over 30 years and also the music director and a member of the church choir.
