And a resident of Mt. Hermon died Saturday night April 14, 2018 at his home. He was a native of Marksville before joining the United States Marine Corps after high school. Lynn served his country from 1961 until 1966 and later was a proud member of the American Legion Post 24 in Bogalusa. Following his years in the Marine Corps, he moved to Washington Parish where he began a career with the Franklinton Police Department. Lynn served as Police Chief for the majority of his 36 year tenure before retiring. He also worked with the Washington Parish Sheriff's Office for several years as a deputy and detective. Lynn was the owner of the Franklinton Cleaners for many years and also owned Granny's Bait Shop and two different donut shops in town. Upon retirement, Lynn also started a business providing bulldozer and heavy equipment work throughout the parish. He always enjoyed hunting and fishing, woodworking and watching old western movies.
