She was born January, 12, 1936, in Independence, LA, to John and Genevieve Gennaro. The eighty-eight-year-old was the last surviving of the six children (Sam Gennaro, Anthony Gennaro, Josephine Garafola, Pauline Magliolo, and Virginia Armato).

Manette was always a friendly and energetic lady. She was well-rounded in high school before attending Spencer Business College. During college days she met her sweetheart, the late Carey Bateman, and married him shortly after graduation. They moved to his hometown of Franklinton and began their life together. While he was away in Korea, Manette lived with his parents (Robert and Sadie Bateman) and was employed by several local businesses. She later worked beside her husband at Allstate Insurance before retiring to grandparenting, growing roses, walking, and traveling. Not to be downplayed was her years of civic and social activities with the Shasta Club.

A devout Roman Catholic, Manette immediately joined her faith family of Holy Family Catholic Church. As a member of the altar and rosary society she served the Lord through the church’s many ministries. She especially

treasured time spent in intimate prayer groups and with shut-ins during her distribution of the Eucharist. She left a library of highlighted spiritual readings in her home.
