MARCUS ELISHA BRUMFIELD, AGE 89

And a resident of Franklinton died at 4:00 pm Saturday March 21, 2009 at Riverside Medical Center. He was a longtime member and Sunday school teacher at Acys Creek Missionary Baptist Church. He was a proud and accomplished gardener and was retired from Petrolane Gas Co. after performing service in the area for many years. He remained always a loving father and grandfather.

Mr. Brumfield honorably served his country during World War II in the 78th Infantry of the U.S. Army, with whom he fought in the Ardennes Forest Campaign and after intense fighting with heavy casualties on March 7-17, 1945 his unit was the first to cross the Rhine River over the Ludendorff Bridge at Remagen, Germany.
