MAX OLIVER BRUMFIELD, JR, AGE 74

And a resident of Franklinton died at 12:15 AM Friday, April 19, 2013 at Lakeview Regional Medical Center in Covington. He was a veteran of the United States Navy during the early years of the Vietnam Era and a member of the USS Helena Organization, which was the battleship he was stationed on. Max was a member of the Masonic Lodge of Baker, Grand Lodge of Louisiana #441, the American Legion Post #113, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #7196. He was also a longtime deputy with the Washington Parish Sheriff's Office under several administrations and retired after nearly 40 years of service to his community.
