



Rev. Frederick Brumfield

October 4, 1971 - June 6, 2025

Frederick John Brumfield, a beloved husband, grandfather, uncle, pastor and friend passed away Friday night June 6, 2025, at the age of 53. He leaves behind a wonderful legacy of profound faith, unwavering love and selfless service that touched countless lives. He was a true servant of God and a true example of such to his family, friends, and all that knew him.

Frederick was born in Franklinton, Louisiana on October 4, 1971, and at a very young age felt the divine call to the ministry and dedicated his life to spreading the Gospel and serving his community. While just a teenager at Bowling Green School, he led many morning prayers and devotionals for the students there. Even then, he was a leader and someone that was highly regarded.

Frederick served as youth pastor and pastor at several surrounding churches; however, for the past 22 years he has served at Palestine Baptist Church impacting the lives of many through his compassionate leadership, unwavering faith, powerful sermons and heartfelt counseling.
