



Dr. Robert L. Rollins

November 28, 1929 - September 26, 2007

ROBERT L. "Bob" ROLLINS, Jr., DVM age 77

a native of Mississippi and longtime resident of Franklinton, LA died at 7:23 PM Wednesday, Sept. 26, 2007 at University Medical Center in Jackson, MS from complications after an ATV accident in August. Dr. Rollins practiced a veterinary career for nearly 50 years. He attended Southwest Miss. Jr. College and later graduated from the Auburn University School of Veterinary Medicine in 1958. He was a member and past president of the La. Veterinary Medical Assn., and the Miss. Veterinary Medicine Assn.; served on the Board of Directors of the LSU School of Veterinary Medicine for 15 years. He operated Franklinton Animal Clinic for many years. He was a longtime member of the Franklinton Country Club where he served as board member and board president. He was a member and deacon of the Clifton Baptist Church and a 50 year member of Franklinton Masonic Lodge #101 and Jerusalem Temple Shrine.
