Roselyn Virginia Wynn Vise, age 79, and a resident of Franklinton, passed away peacefully in her sleep the morning of August 5th, 2014.

Miss Rose, as she was affectionately known, was born in Etowah County, Alabama on October 17, 1934. She often spoke of becoming a Christian when she visited a Methodist Camp Meeting at the age of 11.
