SANDY LANG CORKERN, AGE 62

And a resident of Franklinton, former resident of New Orleans and Franklin, Louisiana died Sunday, September 20, 2009 at St. Tammany Parish Hospital in Covington.

Sandy was a marine advisory agent with the Louisiana Cooperative Extension Service through LSU for 24 years. He served as Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force and earned a Masters of Science degree in Zoology from Southeastern Louisiana University. He was a Master Mason at Pine Lodge # 264, and a vestry member, lector and Lay Eucharistic Minister at St. Matthew Episcopal Church in Bogalusa. Sandy was also a member of MAC-Motorcycle Awareness Campaign and an alumnus of Theta Xi Fraternity.
