Vernon laid the brick and helped construct numerous projects, both large and small, across Washington Parish. He built the Washington Parish and Bogalusa jails, Rayburn Correctional Institute buildings, numerous churches and homes, and he was proud to have done the masonry for all the fireplaces in the historic cabins of Mile Branch Settlement. Vernon enjoyed gardening, especially strawberries, and he often sold large amounts of strawberry plants to others in the area. He liked to do tractor work around his property and woodworking projects. Vernon enjoyed reading western novels and watching old western TV shows and movies as well as watching different sports on TV. He was a longtime active member of Pine Missionary Baptist Church, who never met a stranger, often visiting with people he just met. Vernon was forever a loving husband, father and grandfather.
