VICK ADRIAN STRINGFIELD, AGE 76

And a resident of Franklinton went to be with his Lord at 3:30 pm Tuesday July 14, 2009 at St. Tammany Parish Hospital. Mr. Stringfield was a graduate of Franklinton High School and Mr. FHS in 1951. He was a Louisiana Star Dairy Farmer of the FFA during that time, later owning and operating his own dairy for 35 years. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of the Korean War stationed on the USS Valley Forge. Mr. Stringfield was a retired cable repair man with Bellsouth and he served as a Justice of the Peace in Washington Parish for 28 years. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Franklinton and an ordained deacon and also an active member of the Senior Adult Choir and Merry Hearts. He was married for 58 years and was always a loving husband, father and grandfather.
